Alistair Robertson House was formerly a substantial private residence built in 1940 located just off the High Street and bequeathed to The Abbeyfield Society by the Local Doctor hence the name Alistair Robertson House. The house was renovated and can now accommodate nine residents in private self contained rooms over two floors and in one self contained cottage.

All rooms are en-suite or have access to the sole use of a bathroom. The rooms are available unfurnished so you are able to bring your own furniture and belongings with you making it a home from home. The House also has a beautiful and secluded garden where garden parties are enjoyed in the summer and residents can sit outside at their leisure and enjoy the seasonal flowers in bloom.


