


Meals



About us

This sheltered house consists of 11 self-contained bedsits and was opened in 2000. All rooms are en-suite and partly furnished, so that you can bring your own furniture, making it a home from home. We also have a re-furbished one bedroomed flat suitable for a single person or a couple.

Residents have the privacy of their own suite. All our rooms are double glazed and look out directly on to the street, so that they can watch the world go by and feel part of the community. Or, of course, they can go out and join in if they wish.

A telephone point is available in each room. You can use your own TV in your room. Sky TV is available.

The dining area doubles as a common entertainment and TV lounge. Residents can also watch DVDs in this area on a large TV.

We also have a smaller lounge where residents can entertain guests or just take a few quiet moments away when they want to be out of their own room. For dry days our patio garden is a place to relax or to help with the gardening.

We also have a fully assisted bathroom for residents who may be less mobile or need assistance. Our in-house laundry facilities mean that we can provide a discreet, speedy service for all your day-to-day
