You can't enjoy peace of mind without trust.

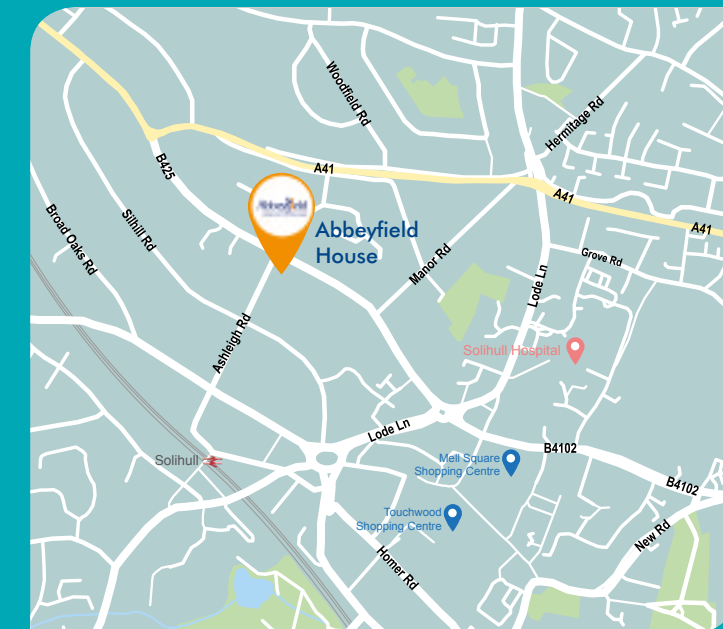
This is why Abbeyfield House is registered and regulated by the Regulator of Social Housing.
