Connected by our staff and volunteers, people who choose to share their time with you organising popping in for a cup of tea and a chat, or being involved in the day-to-day life of our scheme.

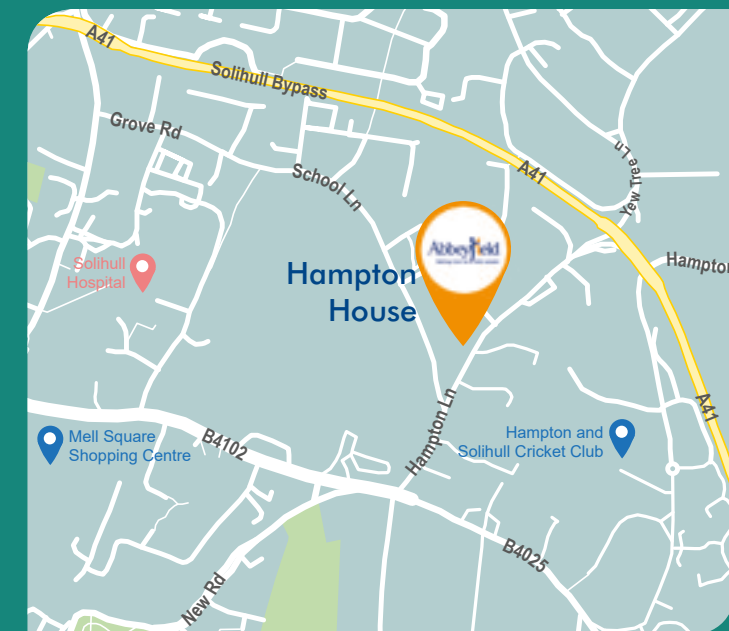
We have established connections with people in our local community who offer varied conversation and a chance to compare different experiences. Variety is the key to any community and we're very proud to offer this at Hampton House.
