This is why Jim Gillespie House is registered and regulated by the Care Quality Commission, the UK's independent regulatory body.

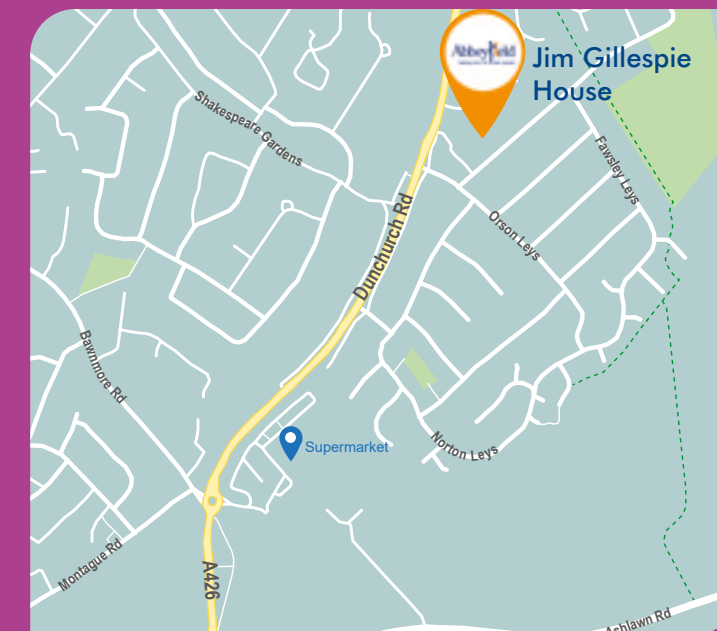
But our quality control doesn't end there – the opinions of our residents matter too. We have regular resident and family meetings, so we can get feedback on how we can improve our service at the home.
